



## **Coronavirus / Covid-19 – our response**

With the situation regarding Coronavirus / Covid -19 remaining very fluid, we continue to monitor updates from the government on a daily basis.

We are committed to protecting people we support during this time and have developed continuity plans to ensure the support we provide is compliant and safe, within the guidelines.

We are continually monitoring and adapting our plans as more updates become available from the Government and Public Health England.

Public Health England has also provided guidance to residential care, supported living and home care settings, which we will continue to monitor closely, even though we are a Day Centre.

At the request of the local authority the Centre closed to receiving our Members in mid-April. We now support a number of our members (and provide indirect support to carers and families) at home or in the community. This we do whilst we have access to PPE.

We shall inform our Members and their carers when the Centre is expected to open again.

Our Management team (including Trustees) are involved in discussions and communications regarding changes in the situation and agree any new actions that we will take. Following those discussions, all staff are being briefed on the latest advice from government and other official sources. Posters regarding changes in practice, PPE etc are on display for all employees (and any visitors) to see.
